For the Council to assess your qualification, you need to provide the following Academic Syllabus (Curriculum) information.

- 1. Title of the qualification programme
- 2. Name of the provider of the qualification programme
- 3. A general outline of the programme and its structure, including:
 - The year(s) the curriculum information relates to
 - Number of years it takes to gain this qualification
 - Identification of compulsory and optional subjects
 - How students gain clinical experience
- 4. Individual course prescriptions with learning outcomes including:
 - Subject names and the topics studied within each subject area
 - The learning outcomes and level of study for the student in each subject area
 - The number of credits/hours of study required for each subject area
- 5. Description of the clinical component of the programme (for example):
 - Clinical work experience
 - Clinical tutorials
 - Time spent in clinical practice
 - Record of clinical work
- 6. Description of how the programme assesses the student's clinical competency
