YOUR RESPONSIBILITY

Once you are registered, you have a legal requirement to notify the Council of any changes to your residential, postal or work address within one month of the change. You can do this by logging into "My Profile" on the website.

Council's Responsibility

The primary responsibility of the Council is to protect the health and safety of the New Zealand public by ensuring practitioners registered in the professions of medical laboratory science, and anaesthetic technology are competent and fit to practise.

APC Renewals

Some changes in the Office

The MSC Council works very closely with the Medical Radiation Technologists Board (MRTB), with whom they set up a jointly-owned company, Medical Sciences Secretariat (MSS). MSS has a governance board comprised of Directors who come from the MRTB and the MSC.

To strengthen the succession planning for MSS, the Board of Directors has recently been increased from four to six, with three Directors coming from the MSC and three from the MRTB.

The MSS staff also welcomes two new staff members; Isabella Rarm who joins the Registration Team and Melissa Buist, Assistant to the Chief Executive.
